

CELEBRATE OUR 100th BY GOING TO ISRAEL-PALESTINE!

Are you interested in walking in the footsteps of Jesus? If so, please contact Glenda in our office at Glenda@fccnh.org or 818-763-8218 to let her know that you are interested in learning more. Currently, we are looking to go in May 2024, spending approximately 10 nights (four in Bethlehem, three in Jerusalem, and three in Nazareth). The tour group will be private, so it will only include our congregation and friends who we invite. We will be using a tour company that has led numerous groups from our denomination.

The cost will depend on the size of our group, any additional days/activities that we wish to add, etc. To estimate, it will be approximately \$1,300 to \$1,600 per person. If you wish to have a private room, it will be \$450 more. This amount includes accommodation, breakfast and dinner, guide, transportation, and entrance fees. It does not include airfare, lunches, tips, or any activities on the free day.

This trip will be one of numerous occasions where we celebrate our congregation's 100th anniversary. Other opportunities will include mission experiences, camping trips, etc.
